
## HOLIDAY WORD LADDERS

Change 1 letter to mean the glass in a window.


Change 1 letter to mean a striped holiday candy.

Change 2 letters to mean spin your body around.

Change 2 letters to mean a quiz.

Change 1 letter to mean the opposite of "worst."

Change 1 letter to mean a red vegetable.

Change 1 letter to mean a part of your body.

Change 1 letter to mean a part of a guitar or to worry about something.

Change one letter to mean it doesn't cost anything.

Change one letter to mean an evergreen.

Change 1 letter to make a word that means "to be angry or upset about someone or something unfair."

Add 2 letters after the "s" to make a person who lives in a place.

Add 1 letter to the beginning and end to make what George Washington and Abraham Lincoln were.

Remove 2 letters to make another word for gifts.
