SET YOUR READING SPEEDOMETER



When a text is quite hard or has lots of information, we read slowly and carefully, like an old jalopy putt-putt-putting down the road. We don't want to miss a single detail.

When a text is quite easy and we're just reading for enjoyment, we read at a smooth, safe pace. We sometimes slow down and sometimes speed up, just like riding in the family car.





When we want to find a specific detail, or just get the general idea of what the text is about, we read like a race car. We zoom our eyes over the page without reading every word.
