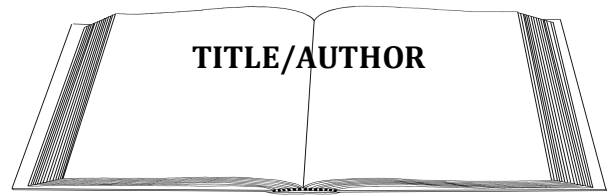


PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER
